William Glackin

Mr. Glackin began his career at The Sacramento Bee in 1948, and continued it for over 50 years. He earned a national reputation for his knowledge of the arts, and for his integrity as a writer. He was born in Sacramento and attended St. Francis School and Christian Brothers High School. He received his Bachelor's degree in physics from St. Mary's College and completed two years of graduate work at the University of California, Berkeley, taking English and education courses.

William Glackin is remembered as a journalist who helped open doors for many young artists by introducing them to his readers. He was someone who believed in encouraging people, and finding something in every performance that was good. Mr. Glackin was someone, who genuinely loved and supported the arts.

The Sacramento Bee honors his legacy by establishing the William Glackin Scholarship. Each year, the award will be presented to a student pursuing a degree in Dance, Theatre, Music or Arts Management, who embodies the same appreciation and respect for the arts.

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must reside in The Bee's Metropolitan Circulation area that includes Amador, El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Solano, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties.
- Applicants must be graduating high school seniors who are accepted at an accredited school of higher education or college students attending an accredited school. This includes a 4-year college or university, 2-year community or junior college.
- College students must have completed at least one term and have one remaining before completion.
- High school applicants should have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and college students a grade point average of 2.5.
- Employees of The Sacramento Bee or McClatchy Newspapers or members of their immediate families are not eligible for this award.

MATERIALS REQUESTED

- Essay: Provide a 1,000 to 1,500-word essay explaining your interest in the arts. Please include your educational goals and how they relate to your career objectives.
- Resume (include scholastic honors, student activities, community service and work experience).
- Portfolio samples if applicable. Up to six samples will be accepted, including videos and CDs.
- Transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (one from an advisor/teacher).

FINANCIAL AWARD

The William Glackin Scholarship recipient will receive **\$2,500**
